The law governing local authorities and their groupings has undergone many changes over the last ten years: Territorial authorities reform bill (RCT-*Réforme des collectivités territoriales*) of 16th December 2010, the Law for the modernisation of territorial public action and the assertion of metropolises (MAPTAM- *Loi de modernisation de l'action publique territoriale et d'affirmation des métropoles*) of 27th January 2014, Law regarding the new territorial organisation of the French Republic (NOTRe- *Loi portant sur la nouvelle organisation territoriale de la République*) of 7th August 2015, the Commitment and Proximity law (*loi engagement et proximité*) of 27th December 2019, etc.
