


Environmental Law

ADALTYs has developed recognised expertise in the issues associated with these types of projects and in particular with regard to environmental assessment procedures (projects, plans and programmes, Natura 2000), procedures before the National Commission for Public Debate (Commission nationale du débat public), environmental consultations and public enquiries, environmental mitigation, exemptions for species and environmental authorisations, etc.

ADALTYs advises and litigates on behalf of renewable energy operators (photovoltaic, wind turbines), on water and hydroelectricity law issues, or advises industrialists on issues related to Installations classified for the protection of the environment (ICPE- Installation Classée pour la Protection de l'Environnement) and/or polluted soils, or risks (Natural Risk Prevention Plans (PPRN- Plans de Prévention des Risques Naturels) / Technological Risk Prevention Plans (PPRT- Plans de Prévention des Risques Technologiques)).
